We received a call at 1 a.m. that two people were lost above Humber Park and were calling for help. A responding Sheriff's deputy turned on his unit's flashing lights so that the hikers could see them. The subjects managed to hike towards the lights and find the trail. RMRU was called off at 2 a.m.
