We received a call at 4 p.m. that two Marines were calling for help on the upper section of the Skyline Trail. The Marines had become separated from a larger group and had run out of water. While RMRU members were en route to the Palm Springs Aerial Tramway, State Park Rangers reached the subjects, gave them water, and helped them up the final 1,000 feet to the Upper Tramway. RMRU was called off at 5 p.m.

Each member purchases their own equipment and takes time off work, without compensation, to participate in search and rescue missions.
