On Sunday Evening at about 9:30pm RMRU was called to foothills of Riverside near the University of Riverside. Two hikers had found themselves stuck on a rock outcropping to the west of the "Big C Trail."

Upon arrival, team members met with the Riverside County Sheriff's and spoke with the helicopter overhead to pin point the location of the two hikers. After a short hike, RMRU could provide some needed water and light for the subjects. A short time later, both hikers and RMRU team members were back at the base without incident.
