BOARD MEETING: 1800 on 27 April at Sir George's Smorgasbord near the Riverside Plaza.

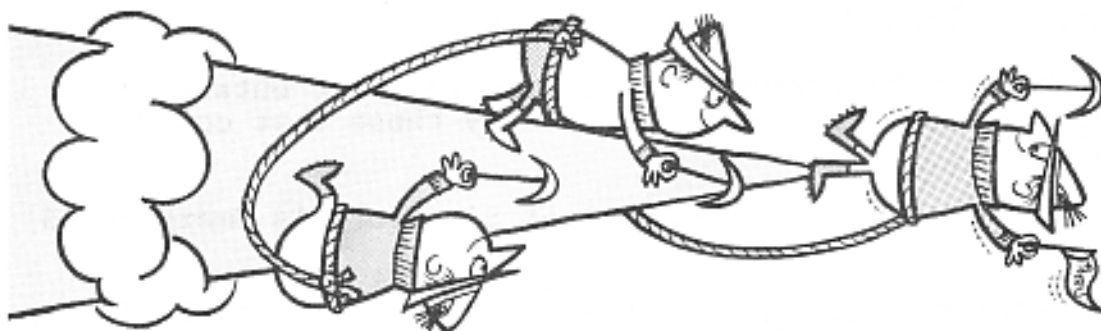

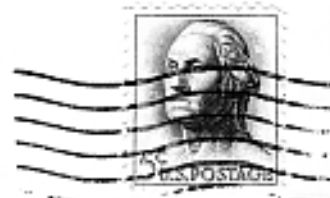
