BOARD MEETING: 1900 on 17 May at Larry Percy's home. This will be the first meeting of the new board.

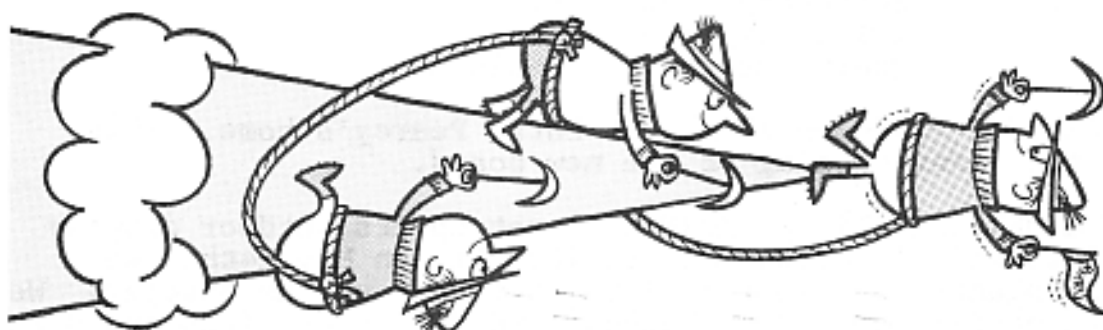
