REGULAR MEETING: 1930 on 25 October at Highland Outfitters. Details of the 1968 training schedule will be discussed. Also, final plans for the workshop will be discussed.

SCR-MRA WORKSHOP: The region workshop will start at 0900 on 28 October. The Montrose Search & Rescue Team will be in charge of plans for the weekend. This workshop is taking the place of our regular training session.

HAPPENINGS: Search: 18-20 September. The National Park Service at Yosemite requested help in finding a park ranger who was overdue from a hike in the Matterhorn Peak area. Men from Sierra Madre, China Lake and RMRU participated in the search. The ranger was found dead, with death caused by falling from technical terrain.

Search: 29 September. The Riverside County Sheriff's Department requested help in locating a possible suicide victim in the Corona area. Part of the team arrived at the scene before noon. The search was started in the Prado Dam area. Footprints of a size like the victims were located. The dog was fired but with no success. The rest of the team was called out at 1700 and searched the wooded area near the scout camp most of the night. Nothing was found and at this time the victim is still listed as missing.

The above search prempted the slide shooting session that was scheduled. The slide shooting session has been tentatively scheduled for .17 and 18 November if weather permits.
